Michael Cline (b. 1973 in Cape Canaveral, FL); lives and works in New York, NY. Cline has presented solo exhibitions with Corbett vs. Dempsey, Chicago; David Kordansky, Los Angeles; Marc Jancou Contemporary, New York; and Daniel Reich Gallery, New York. His works have been included in group exhibitions organized by the Parrish Art Museum, New York; Galleria Nazionale d'Arte Contemporanea, Rome; Deste Foundation, Athens; David Zwirner, New York; Lehmann Maupin, New York; Saatchi Gallery, London. Cline's paintings are included in the collections of the Museum of Modern Art, New York; the Walker Art Center, Minneapolis; François Pinault Foundation, Venice; and the Museum of Old and New Art, Tasmania.
